

## **Installation Instructions EZ Headset Holder**

## (Scan QR Code for Install Video)

- 1. Select a suitable location in the cockpit to install the EZ Headset Holder, keeping in mind any potential interference with vents, controls, or compasses.
- 2. Test fit the EZ Headset Holder in the selected location, ensuring that it fits securely and does not interfere with any cockpit instrumentation or controls.
- 3. Before installing the EZ Headset Holder, remove the protective plastic film from the suction cup and clean the suction cup bottom with the provided alcohol wipe. Additionally, clean the area in the cockpit where the suction cup will be installed.
- 4. <u>Critical Step!</u> Ensure that the suction cup is not "locked down" and the arm of the suction cup is up before proceeding.
- 5. Take the 3M VHB disk and remove the lighter colored protective film. Center the disk on the suction cup and roll it onto the bottom of the suction cup, ensuring that no air bubbles form.
- 6. Remove the top red protective film from the VHB, then tilt the EZ Headset Holder to start at one end and work towards the other end to prevent air bubbles from forming. Once the VHB is secure, flip the lock arm of the suction cup down to finally secure the suction cup holder.
- 7. Adjust the EZ Headset Holder as needed and tighten both adjustment fasteners to secure it in place.
- 8. Before using the EZ Headset Holder, ensure that it is securely fastened to the suction cup and that the adjustments are properly tightened.
- 9. Enjoy using your EZ Headset Holder!

## **Warnings:**

- A. **DO NOT** store headsets on the EZ Headset Holder during taxiing, takeoff, landing, or any other part of the flight when the engine is running. This could lead to damage to the headset and could potentially interfere with the safe operation of the aircraft.
- B. **BEFORE EVERY FLIGHT**, ensure that the EZ Headset Holder is securely mounted to its location and that both adjustment screws are properly fastened. Failure to do so could result in the EZ Headset Holder becoming loose or detached during flight, which could cause injury or damage to the aircraft.
- C. **NEVER** use the EZ Headset Holder as a substitute for securing or stowing a headset in the appropriate location during flight. The EZ Headset Holder is only intended for use when the headset is not in use and the aircraft is not in motion.
- D. **FAILURE TO FOLLOW** these warnings and all other instructions provided with the EZ Headset Holder could result in serious injury, death, or damage to the aircraft, and could render the user liable for any resulting damages.
